

NUC APPROVES FOUR NEW PROGRAMMES FOR REDEEMER'S UNIVERSITY

he National Universities Commission (NUC) has approved four new programs for Redeemer's University, Ede, Osun State. The programs are B.Sc. in Cyber Security, B. Sc. in Information Technology, M. Phil and Ph.D. in Biochemistry, and PGD, M.Sc., and Ph.D. in Finance.

According to the letter signed by Dr. N.B. Saliu, Director of Academic Planning, National Universities Commission, on behalf of the commission's Executive Secretary, Professor Abubakar Rasheed, all the approved programmes would take a full-time mode of delivery and be run in the main campus of the University with effect from the 2022/2023 academic session.

Meanwhile, the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Anthony Akinlo, was elated to receive the news of the approval for the new programmes and commended everyone that worked towards the success of the resource verifications. He added that the approval would further energise the University's commitment to providing educational services that enhance the employability of its graduates in the competitive labour market and position the institution as a leading citadel of learning in Nigeria.

- Apples are high-fibre fruits, meaning that eating them could boost heart health and promote weight loss. The pectin in apples helps to maintain good gut health.
- Apples also have high levels of quercetin, a flavonoid which may have anti-cancer properties.

One study found that people who ate whole apples were 30 percent less likely to be obese than those who did not. This can lower the risk for diabetes and heart disease.

One medium apple contains the following nutrients:

- 95 calories
- 25.13 g of carbohydrate
- 4.4 g of fibre
- 195 mg of potassium
- 11 mg calcium
- 8.4 mg vitamin C

Research has shown that there is a link between eating apples regularly and a lower risk of cardiovascular disease, certain cancers, and diabetes.
