ACEGID, ILLUMINA TO BOOST AFRICA'S GENOMIC CAPACITY, ESTABLISH JOINT ACADEMY

he African Centre of Excellence for Genomics of Infectious Diseases (ACEGID), Redeemer's University, Ede, Osun State, Nigeria, has announced that it will collaborate with Illumina, a global leader in sequencing and array-based technologies, on a joint workforce development training academy, with the aim of boosting Africa's genomics capacity.

ACEGID and Illumina, in February, signed a memorandum of understanding and will work towards an

agreement to leverage the existing pathogen Genomics and Bioinformatics Bootcamp program at ACEGID, to set up an ambitious training program targeting 1,000 young African researchers and scientists in Genomics and Bioinformatics between March 2023 and December 2025. This will significantly increase the supply of qualified technical workforce for next-generation sequencing wet lab management, bioinformatics, big data analytics, advanced artificial intelligence; and machine

learning applications.

Aside from the proposed academy, Illumina and ACEGID will also explore the implementation of a "mobile labin-container" that will enable realtime and on-the-move sequencing for outbreak responses in West Africa. This new program fits into ACEGID's SENTINEL pandemic preparedness and response program of identifying pathogens with pandemic potentials in the field before they can wreak havoc.

alliance, Professor Christian Happi, ACEGID's boss, explained that cooperation with Illumina is in complete alignment with the mandate of ACEGID, which is to train a critical mass of young African scientists that will use genomics tools and technologies to address public health challenges in Africa.

He further noted that what is unique about this cooperation is that both Illumina and ACEGID are agreeing to put in place the necessary infrastructure for training in genomics, research, and innovation that is going bevond infectious diseases also to address the issues of noncommunicable diseases. The partnership is expected to be a landmark in the African genomics and public health space which is tailored towards addressing the needs for both human resources development and infrastructure for proper training to enable increased capacity for genomics on the continent.

"We share a collective goal with ACEGID of extending

the reach of genomic technologies and their impacts for patients," said Susan Tousi, Chief Commercial Officer of Illumina. "Africa has the greatest genetic diversity of any continent, and this opportunity to contribute to the future of accessing that diversity for the benefit of human health is one Illumina is proud to support".

Illumina chief added that the two organizations will also work towards collaborations for pharmacogenomics which is the study of how genes affect a Continued from Pg. 1

person's response to drugs and precision oncology which has to do with the treatment of cancers based on the specific genes that cause cancerous growth in a patient for Africans.

Explaining the mission of his company, Illumina Chief Executive Officer, Francis DeSouza, stated that making precision medicine a reality for all populations is core to Illumina's mission to improve human health by unlocking the power of the genome, noting that today, only two percent of genomic data comes from African individuals, and we are committed to changing that. It begins with empowering local scientists and researchers with tools, resources, and training on the power of genomics.

"Our work with Prof. Happi and ACEGID builds on our goal to rapidly expand sequencing capabilities and capacity for all people in Africa, and will impact every area of precision medicine, from drug development to cancer screening, therapy selection, and monitoring," he highlighted.

Dr. Wale Adewuji who is the Director of Research had the honor of taking the representatives of the National Universities Commission on a tour through the university. From the lecture halls, to the post graduates hostels and colleges where they met with the Provost of the College of Postgraduate Studies in person of Prof. O. G. Adevemi. He received the quests with much delight and eustacy. while he went further to explain the history of the existence of the PG programme even to when it was accredited in the university. He also took them round the buildings, showing them the various lecture classrooms, and the several awards that are in the post graduate

Still on the tour, they visited the Africa Center of Excellence for Genomics and Infectious Diseases (ACEGID). The Deputy Director; Prof. Onikepe Folarin received the representatives with a big smile, while she briefly gave an overview of what ACEGID is all about and what it entails, reason for its existence and the role it has played in the world at large. Giving a historical perspective, The Africa Centre of Excellence for Genomics of Infectious Diseases (ACEGID) was founded in 2013. In 2014, they had their first index case of Ebola outbreak, the role of ACEGID in curbing the spread, and managing the situation from Sierra Leone to Nigeria. She also mentioned the ways and methods they use to ensure that infectious diseases are contained to a large extent so it does not affect the institution and the state. Still talking with the NUC representatives, she introduced the Project Manger; Prof. Philomena Eronmo, who shed light on the various buildings, and equipment. She explained the function of the research lab, where researches are carried out, DNA rooms for collection of samples, e.t.c. To further buttress the importance of the ACEGID, Prof. analysed the Onikepe Folarin impact of the Covid-19 Pandemic on their operations, and the use of different machines in the laboratory to ensure the safety of the Redeemers University staffs and wards. Worthy of note is the fact that they are in a well recognized partnership with the World

Health Organization (W.H.O), NCCDC and NAFDAC. Prof. (Mrs.) Onikepe also mentioned that the Redeemers University is still open for growth, and to this effect they are working effortlessly to make sure that they move to their permanent site of the building still in within the premises in no distant time.

On sight seeing, the permanent site the technological advancement, implantation of the solar system, inverters and the wide and commodious space was also not left out.

The guests also took out time to visit the Centre for Chemical and Bio-Chemical Research, where Dr. Alfred who is a member of the board took them round the centre. In the Engineering Departments, they were introduced to the different machines and their functions, the various laboratory studios, fluid mechanics, hydrology, and others.

Dr. Ropo Dairo, who is the head of department of Electrical Engineering Department also briefed them on the maintenance workshop. Furthermore, the guests visited the school hostels for both the male and female gender, inspected how clean their environment was, the school cafeteria, to see how structured they are. They also went round the university premises for sight seeing. And after their tour, they returned to the Vice-Chancellor's office for the signing of some documents while commending the efforts of the management in maintaining such a great standard.

REDEEMER'S UNIVERSITY DOES NOT EMBELISH RESOURCES FOR ACCREDITATION

he Vice-Chancellor of Redeemer's University, Ede, Osun State, Professor Anthony Akinlo, has said that the institution does not borrow equipment or embellish resources to get approval for National Universities Commission (NUC) accreditation.

He made this statement while receiving the teams from the apex regulatory body for Nigerian universities in his office, recently. He added that everything that was being presented for the resource verification is owned by the institution.

Responding to Professor Akinlo's opening, Professor Joseph Kerker, a team leader of NUC's Resource Verification for Master of Arts and Doctor of Philosophy in Christian Religious Studies, noted that for any university to be given

UWC APPOINTS RCBC PROVOST AS EXTRAORDINARY PROFESSOR

he Provost of the R e d e e m e d Christian Bible College (RCBC), Professor Babatunde Adedibu has been appointed as an Extraordinary Professor by the University of the Western Cape, South Africa.

In a letter dated 7th March 2023 and jointly signed by the University's Deputy Vice-Chancellor Academic, Professor Vivienne Lawack, and Dean Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Professor Monwabi Knowledge Ralarala, the University authority informed Professor Adedibu that his new appointment was approved by the Joint Appointments and Promotions Committee of Senate and Council of the University on Tuesday 7th March 2023.

Professor Adedibu, a Professor of Church History and Missiology, is expected to bring his wealth of experience

and expertise to bear on the academic life of the University through research, teaching, postgraduate supervision, and consultancy services to the academic programmes of the University.

By this appointment, he has added to his many firsts having been the first full-time head boy of RCBC to become the Provost of the College as well as being the first RCBC Provost to be appointed a University Professor following his appointment as Professor of Church

History and Missiology by Redeemer's University, Ede, Nigeria on October 1, 2020.

He is a Principal Investigator and Grantee of Nagel Institute of Calvin University Project in Engaging African Realities in conjunction with the John Templeton Foundation Research Grant awarded for the research project entitled " The Politics and Poetics of Violent Prayers in Nigerian Pentecostal Churches ". The research team is made up of five interdisciplinary scholars. The project investigates what prayer litigants are doing when they pray "violent" prayers, and what possibilities their religious understanding and experience hold for building a theology of social change and transformation.

His appointment will run for three years and could be reapproved for another three years at its expiration.
